## Wait for Trains at Station Platform

### Attention Amtrak Passenger:

Due to structural damage to the building, the Berlin, CT, station building will close effective Monday, March 9 for a minimum of three weeks while repairs are being made.

During this time, the train will continue to stop at the Berlin station. Passengers can wait for trains on the station platform.

While the station is closed, there will be no access to the waiting room, restroom, or meet and assist services. Additionally, Quik-Trak ticketing kiosks will not be available. Passengers may board the train at Berlin with either an eTicket (printed or displayed on their mobile device) or provide the conductor with their reservation number.

For the most up-to-date departure and arrival times, passengers are encouraged to sign-up for delay notifications when booking their travel and check the status of their train on Amtrak.com, our free mobile apps or at 800-USA-RAIL (1-800-872-7245).
