## CTrail Hartford Line

### *Launching June 16*

### Service:

- Provides fast, convenient and reliable regional passenger rail service.
- Significantly increases weekday roundtrip rail service between New Haven and Springfield, increasing from 6 to 17 per day between New Haven and Hartford, and increasing from 6 to 12 per day between Hartford and Springfield.
- Will consist of a combination of Amtrak and Hartford Line trains.
- Trains will operate at speeds up to 110 MPH, with an average travel time of 81 minutes between New Haven and Springfield.
- Encourages economic growth and development around stations.
- Creates livable and sustainable communities.

### Making Connections:

- Connections in New Haven with New Haven Line trains to New York City.
- Connections in New Haven with Amtrak regional and Acela service.
- Connections in New Haven with Shore Line East rail service.
- Connections in Hartford with Bradley Airport Express bus service.
- Transfers in Hartford with CT**fastrak**.
- Easy transfers in Hartford and New Haven with local transit options.

### Fares, Schedules and Parking Pricing:

- Visit [HartfordLine.com](http://HartfordLine.com) for information on fares, schedules and trip planning.
- Parking is free through September 4, 2018. Paid parking (\$2.00 daily/\$20.00 monthly) will be implemented on that date. CTDOT will provide information on how to use the parking kiosks at the Berlin, Meriden and Wallingford Stations.
- Parking is free on weekends and federal holidays.

### Stations and Amenities:

- New, modern stations in Berlin, Meriden and Wallingford featuring high-level platforms, overhead pedestrian bridges and increased parking.
- Passenger focused amenities including an automatic platform snow melt system, a real time passenger information display system, bike racks, ticket vending machines (TVMs) and electric vehicle charging stations, among others.
- Wallingford Station and Meriden Station opened in November 2017.
- New Haven State Street Station will open in May 2018.
- Berlin Station will partially open in May 2018 and open fully once construction is complete in the fall.
- High-level platforms at Hartford Union Station were opened in Summer 2016.
- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant.
